## TRAILS OPEN - CONDITIONS LIMITED

Trails are open at this time but will close tonight at 11:59PM. Due to the warm weather and rain on the way we are closing trails. Please respect the trail system and enjoy riding tonight prior to their closing.As of right now trails are pretty smooth ahead of a little warmup coming this week with rain in the forecast. We will reopen the trails as conditions allow. We'd like to

thank everyone that took the time to show up to the pancake breakfast and those who put the effort into hosting. If the trails are still open next week we hope you stop in for our spaghetti dinner.**STAY BETWEEN THE STAKES:** We are about to get a section of C-4 Hartfield trail **SHUT DOWN** because riders cannot follow simple instructions to stay between the stakes. Double stakes are there to ensure minimal damage happens to a landowners land. These stakes are not simply a guideline as to where the trail goes. There are there to keep snowmobiles within a specific location on the landowners property. Ride between the stakes or stay home it's that simple, please spread the word.

TRAILS OPEN – Trails are open at this time but use caution until we are able to build up a good base. Temperatures are forecast to warm up on Sunday please watch for trail updates. **\*\*Pancake breakfast at Club House 9am to 11am Saturday 23rd (This Saturday)\*\*** DMV to get registration and Club membership will be open from 9am to 12pm on Saturday Jan 23rd. **\*\*\*\* IF THERE ARE NO SIGNS.... THERE IS NO TRAIL!!!\*\*\*\*** There is limited use on trail 52 Panama state lands to Busti - Ride there only if necessary. **\*\*\*\*48A in French creek completely closed.\*\*\*\*B4\*\*** Bliss Road to Brocton via the rail road bed (rails to trails) is limited snow. MUD around before and after castle. **\*\*\*\*B4\*\*** Stockton to Brocton & **\*\*45\*\*** is CLOSED due to MUD! Early season conditions water holes exist in most of the area so use caution. Have fun and ride safe, There will be a lot of snow out there with hidden dangers so stay on the trail and take it slow. Please report any trail issues you come across via our Facebook Messenger so we can keep them as safe as possible for other riders.

## TRAILS OPEN - CONDITIONS GOOD

Trails are open with early season conditions and many open holes still needing to freeze. Snow depth is ranging from 1 to 2 feet, stay on the trail in the deeper areas. The trail from Brocton to Stockton is very wet and muddy, we may have to close it so if you see signs turn around. Expect to see some wet spots through the weekend. **\*\*\*\* IF THERE ARE NO SIGNS.... THERE IS NO TRAIL!!!\*\*\*\*** Also notice 52s on the Busti trail is closed from hoag rd to the PA state line. **\*\*\*\*48A in French creek completely closed for logging** Please report any trail issues you come across via our Facebook Messenger so we can keep them as safe as possible for other riders.

TRAILS OPEN – Trails are open at this time but use caution until we are able to build up a good base. We've received well over a foot of powder in spots overnight with more on the way today and tomorrow. Temperatures are forecast to be cold for the next week so we should finally see some ground freezing. There is limited use on trail 52 Panama state lands to busti - Ride there only if necessary. 48a in French creek completely closed. Early season conditions with ungroomed trails and water holes exist in most of the area so use caution. Get out and ride to help break in these trails so we can get a good base that will hold a groom. Have fun and ride safe, there will be a lot of snow out there with hidden dangers so stay on the trail and take it slow. Please report any trail issues you come across via our Facebook Messenger so we can keep them as safe as possible for other riders.
