Trail 52 and 41 closed. Brocton and Westfield closed. NOTE SHERMAN TO MAYVILLE IS CLOSED UNTILL GATES ARE OPENED BY LANDOWNER. Do not touch or ride around till he opens them himself. Please do not ride in the closed areas until we have opened them, trails could have been diverted to different locations or there may be impassable hazards. In case you were wondering why our trails were not opened on the 21st, some landowners do not allow us on their property until after hunting season to sign trails. We respect their wishes and club volunteers try to get out as fast as possible to sign remaining trails right after hunting season is over. Please be patient and allow those who are doing this in their free time to finish the process of opening the trails for the start of the season. Our club has the most miles of trails in the county, which takes a bit longer than other clubs to review our portion of trails. We all want to ride but we are out on the trails working and do not want to monitor Facebook for content.
